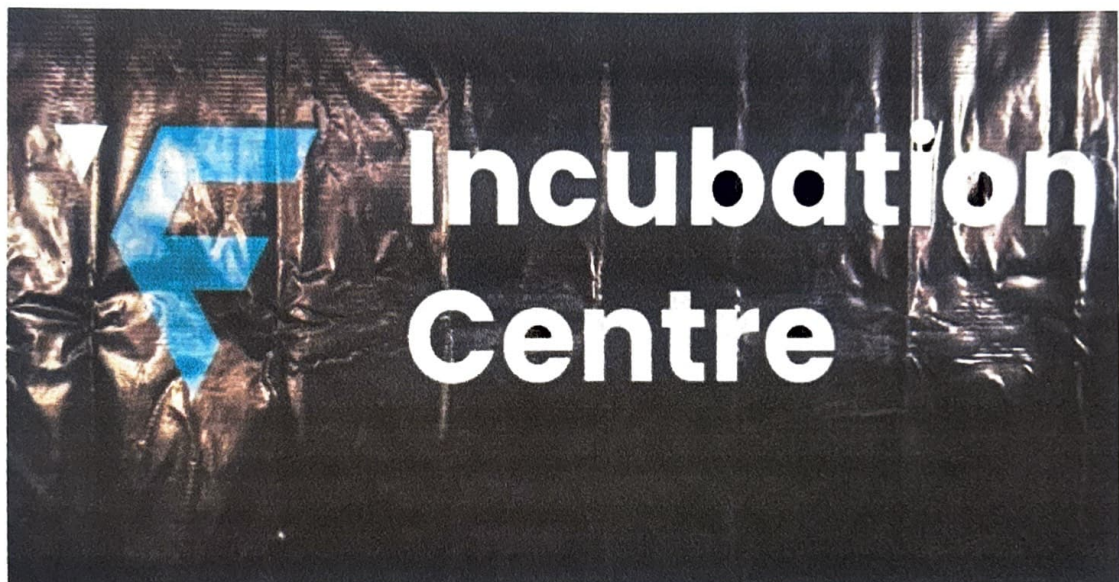

Policy for Incubation Centre / Start-ups / Entrepreneurship Cell

- 1. Introduction:** The **Incubation Centre / Start-ups / Entrepreneurship Cell** aims to foster a culture of innovation and entrepreneurship among students, faculty, and alumni. This policy aligns with UGC and AICTE guidelines and provides a structured framework for supporting start-ups and entrepreneurial initiatives within the institution.




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2. Vision and Mission:

- **Vision:** To develop an ecosystem that nurtures entrepreneurial talent and promotes start-up culture.
- **Mission:** To provide mentorship, infrastructure, funding support, and industry collaboration opportunities for aspiring entrepreneurs.

3. Objectives:

- Encourage students and faculty to develop innovative solutions for real-world problems.
- Facilitate pre-incubation and incubation of start-ups.
- Provide access to mentorship, technical guidance, and financial support.
- Collaborate with industries, government agencies, and investors.
- Organize entrepreneurship development programs, Hackathon, and workshops.

4. Governance and Administration: The Incubation Centre will be governed by a Governing Body comprising:

- Chairperson (Director/Principal of the Institute)
- Faculty Coordinators
- Industry Experts
- Representatives from Alumni Entrepreneurs
- Student Representatives

The **Entrepreneurship Cell (E-Cell)** will function under the Incubation Centre, promoting entrepreneurial activities across campus.

5. Eligibility Criteria for Start-ups:

- Open to students, faculty, staff, and alumni of the institution.
- The business idea should be innovative and scalable.
- The start-up should align with the institution's core academic and research areas.

6. Infrastructure and Support: The Incubation Centre will provide:

- **Office Space & Co-Working Facilities**
- **Computing & Technical Support**
- **Access to Laboratories & Prototyping Facilities**
- **Business & Legal Advisory Services**
- **Networking & Investor Connect Programs**



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7. Funding & Financial Support:

- Institutional seed funding (subject to approval by the Governing Body).
- Assistance in applying for Government Startup Schemes (e.g., Startup India, MSME, DST, AICTE Startup Policy grants).
- Collaboration with venture capitalists and angel investors.

8. Intellectual Property (IP) Rights & Commercialization:

- Any innovation developed under the Incubation Centre will follow the institute's **IPR Policy**.
- The ownership of IP will be determined based on the level of institutional support.
- Licensing and commercialization support will be provided.

9. Training and Capacity Building:

- Regular **Entrepreneurship Development Programs (EDP), Faculty Development Programs (FDP), and Student Innovation Challenges**.
- Collaborations with **Industry Experts, Startup Mentors, and Successful Entrepreneurs**.
- Internship opportunities in start-ups and incubated companies.

10. Exit Policy:

- Start-ups should graduate from the incubation centre within **2-3 years**.
- Exit criteria include achieving self-sustainability, receiving external funding, or exceeding incubation space limitations.

11. Compliance with AICTE & UGC Norms:

- The Incubation Centre will adhere to AICTE's **National Innovation and Startup Policy (NISP)** and UGC's guidelines on entrepreneurship development.
- The institution will integrate start-up-related credits into the academic curriculum where applicable.

12. Monitoring & Evaluation:

- Quarterly reviews and progress tracking of incubated start-ups.
- Annual reports to be submitted to AICTE/UGC and relevant stakeholders.
